Course Description

This course will be dedicated to the fundamentals and technique of basic 35 mm color photography. Emphasis will be placed on creative and artistic aspects and the students will use the city of Barcelona to elaborate and explore their own personal expression. The basis will be local architecture and historical elements in context and juxtaposition with its peoples and culture. Activities will include class and field work, discussions, critique sessions, slide viewing, visits to museums, photography collections, foundations and excursions in and around Barcelona. The objective of this course is to advance knowledge and personal skills relating to photography and aesthetic values in general, and to produce an individual portfolio representing personal feelings and visual impressions of Barcelona. Students will be required to have slides and film developed at their own expense.
