Module Aims

This module aims to enable the student to consider basic design requirements imbedded in the Building Regulations.

Indicative Module Content

- **Introducing the Building Regulations** - Introducing the regulatory documents; Understanding their relevance in designing Interiors; Introducing Liability in relation to negligence
- **Designing with the Building Regulations** – Applying the Technical Guidance Documents (all parts) in the design of Interiors; Designing different building types such as Apartments, Hotels, Restaurants, and Offices, among others
- **Special cases** - Exemptions and relaxation of the Building Regulations; Associated Conservation concerns
- **Completing the Safe Pass training programme**
