Course Description

Format: This course consists of two parts as separate short courses (20 hours each) taught at the University of Barcelona Hispanic Studies Center. This course is offered to students only at Level A.

Objectives Unit 1: Spoken Spanish – Daily Situations

Through this class students will learn about the daily, social, economic and cultural realities of everyday life in Barcelona. The weekly program thus allows students to better familiarize themselves with the Barcelona way of life. In each class students will work the communication functions for each topic, along with its typical linguistic component. Texts and audiovisual resources will be used to strengthen oral expression in the classroom.

Objectives Unit 2: Spanish Conversation

Spanish Conversation is a course designed specifically for foreign students interested in broadening their knowledge, resources and strategies to communicate properly in daily contexts. The aim is to contribute to the production of a fluent and natural speech, improving interaction and using the oral expression and comprehension strategies which are appropriate in different situations.
