### **Spanish Grammar (100 contact hours)**

#### **Advanced Level**

#### **Universidad de Salamanca Language & Culture Program**

The Advanced level grammar course is designed for those students who have completed four semesters of college level Spanish and have a solid working knowledge of Spanish. The overall objective of this level is to enable the student to communicate more accurately and in a more sophisticated manner. The focus is on vocabulary and grammar associated with commercial, professional, and academic situations.

Specific grammar objectives include but are not limited to:

Review of preterite / imperfect.

2. Conditional tense.
3. Past subjunctive.
4. Connectors.
5. Negative words.
6. Verbs of will/ wish/ opinion with subjunctive.
7. Conjunctions of contingency with subjunctive.

The communicative aspect of the class will revolve around the discussion of topics such as the following:

- Asking for information about objects.
- Discussing price.
- Talking about character and personality.
- Referring to what others have said.
- Asking for and giving professional information.
- Expressing and justifying opinions.
- Giving advice and orders.
- Making recommendations and suggestions.
- Rejecting and accepting others opinions.
- Talking about past and present acts.

The student will be evaluated on daily oral and written exercises, classroom participation, a mid-term exam, and a final exam.
