Course Title: **Women in the History of Spain**

Contact hours: 50 (approx. 3 semester credits)

Course Content:

The objective of this module is to study the role of woman in the development of our History. A survey of Spanish History will start from the beginning of the XX century, to the Second Republic (where women's suffrage was allowed in 1931), the Civil War, the Franquismo years, the Transition, and, finally, will end in the present day. All of these themes will be studied through the works of the most representative women in Spain: literary (Emilia Pardo Bazan, Carmen Martin Gaité...), political (Clara Campoamor, Dolores Ibárruri...), philosophical (Maria Zambrano, Celia Amorós...) and artistic (Maria Blanchard, Maria Casares...).
