Academic Studies Abroad is fully committed to financially assisting students who wish to participate on our study abroad programs. Our scholarships illustrate this commitment and our ongoing effort to help keep study abroad affordable.

Scholarship recipients are chosen on a variety of criteria, but scholarships and/or admission into an ASA program are never based on race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, age, gender, or religion.

Academic Studies Abroad is pleased to offer the following scholarships:

ANNUAL AWARDS

- (2) \$1,000 award for **Academic Year** programs
- (5) \$500 awards for a **Fall** Trimester or Semester program
- (5) \$500 awards for a **Winter** or Spring Trimester or Semester program
- (5) \$250 awards for a **Summer** program

To be eligible for any of our scholarships you must meet the following criteria:

- Must have completed at least one semester of college by the time you will be abroad.
- Must be able to demonstrate financial need.

Generally, a copy of your financial aid award letter and a copy of your transcript is enough for us to see financial need, standing in college, and classes taken. If there is anything else you wish to submit that will show us any of the 3 criteria, feel free to include them with your application.
