Scholarship recipients are chosen on a variety of criteria, but scholarships and/or admission into an ASA program are never based on race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, age, gender, or religion.

Academic Studies Abroad is pleased to offer the following scholarships:

### **ANNUAL AWARDS**

- (2) \$1,250 awards for **Academic Year** programs
- (4) \$1,000 awards for **Fall, Winter, or Spring** Trimester or Semester programs
- (4) \$500 awards for a **Fall** Trimester or Semester program
- (4) \$500 awards for a **Winter** or **Spring** Trimester or Semester program
- (5) \$250 awards for a **Summer** program

To be eligible for any of our scholarships you must meet the following criteria:

- Scholarship is only applicable to an ASA study abroad program
- Must submit your complete ASA program application at the same time you submit your complete ASA scholarship application.
- Fill out and submit the Scholarship Application Form on the following page.
- Submit your 1,000-word essay as described on the Scholarship Application.
- Must have completed at least one semester of college by the time you will be abroad. Submit your official college transcript as proof of your standing in college.
- Must be able to demonstrate financial need by submitting a copy of your financial aid award letter.

If there is anything else you wish to submit to support your application, feel free to include it.
