OBJECTIVES: For students to learn about current technical resources and audiovisual technology. Technologies based on digital systems used in the audiovisual field; current videos and electronic images; current and future systems and facilities which students will encounter in their work

COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this course, students will analyze and study current technologies and future trends used in the creation of audiovisual products in telephony, radio, video, television and internet

METHODOLOGY: Classes will be developed using a combination of theoretical explanations and practical demonstrations of equipment in the laboratory and, in addition, the students will undertake group work which will then be presented and discussed in class

EVALUATION: The theory credits will be evaluated by a written exam in which students will have to answer specific or general questions on the aspects studied. The practical credits will be evaluated through individual and group work set throughout the course. The final grade will be made up of 60% for the theory exam grade and 20% for the practical work set in class. The remaining 20% will be based on attendance at class and non-class activities set by the professor that may arise throughout the course, and continuous assessment
