OBJECTIVES: To widen the student's capacity for study, reflection and criticism in relation to the European Union and to the challenges raised by the European integration process. To give students a thorough, practical knowledge of European Union law, and valid tools of analysis for all key areas of European Union law.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Generalities of European Union law: history of the European integration process; institutions and decision-making process; sources; relations between European Union law and internal rules; judicial application of European Union law.
