SPANISH LANGUAGE COURSE - 2022/2023

1. Placement Test

Students will be required to take a placement test on the aforementioned date in order to determine their level and group for enrollment.

2. Schedule

Students have two 1.5-hour sessions a week from Monday to Thursday. Schedules of other courses and degrees are taken into consideration when programming the schedule for the Spanish Language groups.

3. Level Descriptions

Elementary

By the end of the semester students should have obtained an elementary level. Specific level assignments will be defined based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). This course has been designed for students who do not have prior knowledge of Spanish and it is based on a communicative teaching method. According to this approach, the main aim is to enable students to handle elementary oral and written communication situations. During this course student will become familiar with the sounds of Spanish so as to start speaking in this language using adequate structures and vocabulary for this level.

Intermediate

By the end of the semester students should have obtained an intermediate level. Specific level assignments will be defined based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). This course has been designed for students who already have prior knowledge of Spanish and it is based on a communicative teaching method. According to this approach, the main objective is to enable students to handle common oral and written communication situations.

Upper intermediate

By the end of the semester students should have obtained an advanced level. Specific level assignments will be defined based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). This course has been designed for students who already have prior knowledge of Spanish and it is based on a communicative teaching method. According to this approach, the main objective is to enable students to handle advanced oral and written communication situations. During the course students will examine in more depth the differences in the Spanish sounds produced by both native speakers and those who use it as a vehicle for communication. Learners will speak in Spanish using adequate vocabulary for this level.

4. Certificate

The CETT-UB School of Languages, *Escuela de Idiomas CETT-UB*, will issue a certificate accrediting the completion, numbers of hours of instruction, level and grade the student acquired through the course.
